We played minute to win it, and it was a lot harder than it looked. We had to stack cups,

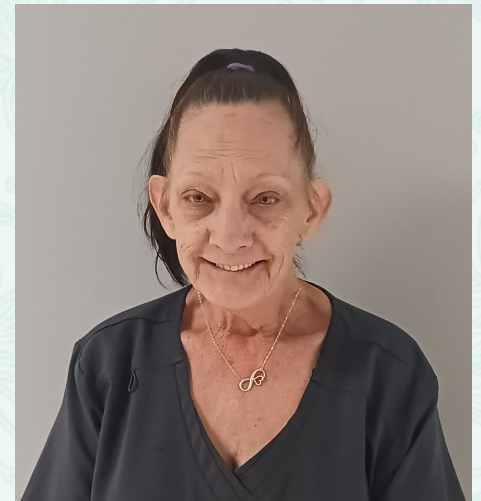


Amy T. doing the cup stacking challenge for minute to win it.
