Thursday was Disney day. We held a Disney themed scavenger hunt and had quite a few Minnie Mouses running around. It isn't "Disney" without those iconic ears.


Friday was PJ day. The best theme day ever. Staff got to wear PJs to work on Friday, and most residents opted to stay in theirs all day, too!

around here!





My favorite way to conserve energy is to spend all day on the couch.


I recycled today. I rode my bike twice!
